

More than 850 people responded in July to a survey, including more than 100 responders from the province of Quebec. Your answers are being used collectively in a Parkinson Canada submission to the Canadian Agency for Drugs and Technologies in Health (CADTH), which is in charge of making recommendations for the public reimbursement of Movapoo®, a drug recently approved for the treatment of "off" periods in Parkinson's disease. 


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### Essayez la boxe à la Grande Randonnée Parkinson!


